On May 28, 2014, Huntsman Corporation (the "Company") issued a press release announcing that it intends to commence an offering of €100.0 million in aggregate principal amount of additional 5.125% senior notes due 2021 (the "Notes") through its wholly owned subsidiary, Huntsman International LLC (the "Issuer"). The Notes are being offered as additional notes under the indenture, dated as of December 23, 2013, among the Issuer, the guarantors party thereto, Wilmington Trust, National Association, as trustee, and Citibank, N.A., London Branch, as paying agent, transfer agent, registrar and authenticating agent, pursuant to which the Issuer previously issued €300.0 million in aggregate principal amount of its 5.125% senior notes due 2021 on December 23, 2013 (the "Initial Notes"). The Notes will be treated as a single series with, and will have the same terms as, the Initial Notes. The Company is filing a copy of the press release as Exhibit 99.1 hereto, which is incorporated by reference to this Item 8.01.

The press release shall not constitute an offer to sell or the solicitation of an offer to buy, nor shall there be any sale of these securities in any state in which the offer, solicitation or sale would be unlawful prior to the registration or qualification under the securities laws of any such state.

Huntsman to Issue Additional 5.125% Senior Notes due 2021

THE WOODLANDS, Texas, May 28, 2014 — Huntsman Corporation (NYSE: HUN) today announced its intention, subject to market and other conditions, to privately offer €100.0 million in aggregate principal amount of additional 5.125% senior notes due 2021 (the “Notes”) through its wholly owned subsidiary, Huntsman International LLC (the “Issuer”). The Notes are being offered as additional notes under the indenture, dated as of December 23, 2013, among the Issuer, the guarantors party thereto, Wilmington Trust, National Association, as trustee, and Citibank, N.A., London Branch, as paying agent, transfer agent, registrar and authenticating agent, pursuant to which the Issuer previously issued €300.0 million in aggregate principal amount of its 5.125% senior notes due 2021 on December 23, 2013 (the “Initial Notes”). The Notes will be treated as a single series with, and will have the same terms as, the Initial Notes.

Huntsman intends to use the net proceeds from the proposed offering for general corporate purposes.

The Notes will not initially be registered under the Securities Act of 1933, as amended (the “Securities Act”), or under any state securities law; and unless so registered, the Notes may not be offered or sold in the United States absent registration or an applicable exemption from, or in a transaction not subject to, the registration requirements of the Securities Act and applicable state securities laws. The Notes are being offered only to qualified institutional buyers under Rule 144A and outside the United States in compliance with Regulation S under the Securities Act.

This press release is neither an offer to sell nor a solicitation of an offer to buy the Notes or any other securities and shall not constitute an offer to sell or a solicitation of an offer to buy, or a sale of, the Notes or any other securities in any jurisdiction in which such offer, solicitation or sale is unlawful.
